



Brenda VanLengen has spent her career championing the importance of education, fitness and sports. The founder of BVonTV etc, Inc, VanLengen is in her 16th year as a sports broadcaster. VanLengen is recognized as one of the top women's sports broadcasters in the country. She has called NCAA Tournament games on ESPN since 1999 and announced the NCAA Division II National Championship for six years. This season, she begins her 14th season as broadcaster for Big 12 Conference Women's Basketball on Fox Sports Net, hosts a national women's sports talk show on SportsRadioKC.com and provides play-by-play on NCAA softball, volleyball and basketball broadcasts.

VanLengen held a leadership position at PE4life, a national non-profit organization, for over nine years and developed the women's sports division at Coach's Edge, which was acquired by Sportvision, where she operated video play animation production equipment for CBS broadcasts of NCAA Men's Basketball. VanLengen also served as the Executive Director of the 1998 NCAA Women's Final Four®.

Prior to her broadcasting career, VanLengen coached basketball for eight seasons, including five at the University of Nebraska. In 2008, she was recognized as a "Distinguished Alumni" of the University of Nebraska at Kearney where she endows a scholarship for the women's basketball program where she was a two-time Academic All-American.

Additionally, VanLengen serves as a motivational speaker, emcees dinners and events, has developed a series of workshops for collegiate student-athletes and coaches at basketball camps for youth.
